Minister:

DEARLY BELOVED, Scripture, in many places, directs us to acknowledge and confess our many sins and wrong doing; and not to hide them from Almighty God, our heavenly Father; but confess them with an humble, penitent and obedient heart; so that we may obtain forgiveness by his infinite goodness and mercy. Although we ought at all times humbly to acknowledge our sins before God; yet chiefly we ought to do so when we meet together to thank him for all the blessings we receive from him, to give him worthy praise, to hear his most holy word, and to ask for the things we need both for our body and soul. Therefore I call on all of you who are present, to accompany me with pure heart and humble voice to the throne of the heavenly grace, saying with me:

All join together in confession:

ALMIGHTY and most merciful God, we have sinned and turned away from your ways like wayward sheep. We have followed too much the desires of our hearts. We have not obeyed your holy laws. We have left undone what we ought to have done, and done things which have been wrong. Lord, be merciful to us who have so greatly offended you. Spare us, O God, as we confess our wrong doing. Restore us who are penitent, according to your promises declared to us in Christ Jesus, our Lord. O merciful Father, for Jesus sake, grant that we may now live a godly, righteous and sober life, to the glory of your Name. Amen.

Minister:

ALMIGHTY God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who does not desire the death of sinners, but rather that they may turn away from their wickedness and live; and has given authority to his ministers to declare to his people, being penitent, the forgiveness of their sins: He pardons and absolves all who truly repent, and without any reserve believe his holy gospel. Wherefore let us humbly ask him to grant us true repentance and his Holy Spirit, that we may do what pleases him, and that the rest of our lives may be pure and holy; so at the last we may come to his eternal joy; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

All join together in the Lord's Prayer:

LORD, our heavenly Father, Almighty and everlasting God, who has safely brought us to the beginning of this day: Defend us during this day with your mighty power; and grant we do not sin, nor find ourselves in any other kind of danger; but in every way we may be ruled by you, to live righteously in you sight; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

LORD our heavenly Father, high and mighty, King of Kings, Lord of lords, the only ruler of those in positions of power; who from your throne observe all people on the earth: From our hearts, we humbly ask you to look with favour on our most gracious Sovereign Lady, Queen *ELIZABETH*; and grant her ever more the grace of your Holy Spirit, that she may always incline to your will, and live according to your ways: generously grant her your heavenly

gifts; bless her with a long and healthy life; may she be given power to overcome all her enemies, and finally after this life that she may attain everlasting joy and happiness; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

AMIGHTY God, the source of all goodness, we humbly ask you to bless *Philip* Duke of Edinburgh, *Charles* Prince of *Wales*, and all the Royal Family; grant them your Holy Spirit; enrich them with your heavenly grace; prosper them with all happiness; and bring them to your everlasting kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**
